

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS (AFTER PREQUALIFICATION)

Subject to conditions prescribed by the University of California San Diego, sealed bids for a CM at Risk contract are invited for the following work:

**5556 64 DEGREES, 64 NORTH, ROGERS MARKET RENOVATION
UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA SAN DIEGO**

Description of Work: In preparation for the opening of the TDLLN project in the fall of 2023, HDH Dining will make changes to our existing operations in the Revelle College community. This project includes renovations to the existing food service platforms to handle the increased undergraduate student population of 2,000.

64 Degrees:

- o Modifications to each of the five (5) service/cooking platforms, reorienting the flow and function of the workspace to improve efficiency and increase seating in both interior and exterior spaces.
- o Purchase new and/or replace existing cooking equipment.
- o Fabrication and or modifications of stainless steel and millwork as required.
- o Provide hot and cold holding areas for Triton2Go program.
- o Include new self-serve Coke Freestyle beverage and water hydration stations in the dining area.

64 North:

- o Build-out of a QSR-style sushi restaurant.
- o Build out a sushi bar with three rolling stations and a supporting prep kitchen using the existing service station.
- o Front of the house needs will include a service counter and work counters with under-counter refrigeration, storage, and POS systems.
- o Back of the house needs will include prep tables, sinks, dry storage, refrigerated and frozen storage.
- o Reorient the interior seating arrangement by utilizing the existing attached meeting room. Provide new and fun exterior seating on the patio.

Roger's Market:

- o Create two distinct businesses, the retail market and the espresso bar all under the same roof. The vision is to create an open and transparent interior and increase retail market products and variety while providing a better flow of customers throughput.
- o Reorient and modify the current espresso bar.
- o Create additional and separate points of sale for the market operation and the espresso bar.
- o Increase shelving and display cases for dry goods, refrigerated items, and frozen products.

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The target date to start renovations is Spring 2023 and work through each area with a project completion date of approximately the beginning of August 2023.

Project duration is 396 calendar days (245 Preconstruction Days and 151 Construction Days).

Bids will be opened: 10:00 A.M., MONDAY, AUGUST 15, 2022 via Zoom.

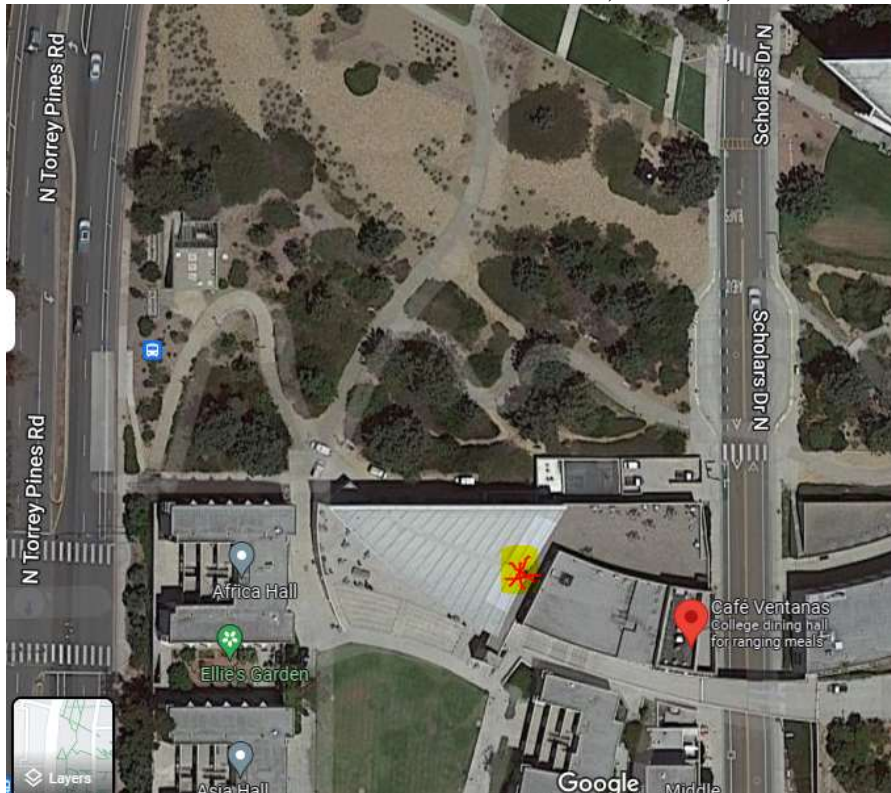

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Bid Security in the amount of 10% of the Anticipated Contract Amount shall accompany each Bid. The surety issuing the Bid Bond shall be, on the Bid Deadline, an admitted surety insurer (as defined in California Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120).

The responsible bidder will be selected on the basis of the best value to the University.

The objective criteria and methodology used to determine Best Value are described in the Bidding Documents. The best value to the University is the selection resulting in the best combination of price and qualifications.

The successful Bidder and its subcontractors will be required to follow the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents and to pay prevailing wage rates at the location of the work. The successful Bidder will be required to have the following California current and active contractor's license at the time of submission of the Bid: B – GENERAL BUILDING CONTRACTOR.

Every effort will be made to ensure that all persons have equal access to contracts and other business opportunities with the University within the limits imposed by law or University policy. Each Bidder may be required to show evidence of its equal employment opportunity policy. The successful Bidder and its subcontractors will be required to follow the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents and to pay prevailing wage at the location of the work.

The work described in the contract is a public work subject to section 1771 of the California Labor Code.

ALL CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS (DIR) AT BID TIME.

Contractors and subcontractors on all public works projects must use the DIR's upgraded electronic certified payroll reporting (eCPR) system to furnish certified payroll records (CPRs) to the Labor Commissioner.

No contractor or subcontractor, regardless of tier, may be listed on a Bid for, or engage in the performance of, any portion of this project, unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 and 1771.1.

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

The successful Bidder shall pay all persons providing construction services and/or any labor on site, including any University location, no less than the UC Fair Wage (defined as \$15 per hour) and shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local working condition requirements.
